Global and Korean Economic Outlook 2H22 “Set to fly? The global economy will face headwinds, with more severe turbulence expected in the EU”

The global economy has been on a roller-coaster ride in 2022. We started the year relatively positive, aided by the normalization of the economy after we gradually emerged from the Covid pandemic. However, the Russia-Ukraine war became a game changer for the global economy. Meanwhile, China’s zero Covid policy exacerbated global supply disruptions. The dynamics of high inflation and slow growth complicate the actions of central banks. At the seminar, the speaker will look at how global and Korean economic growth and inflation pathways will develop for the rest of the year and how policy makers will respond.
